

ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Handique Girls' College is situated in the heart of Guwahati on the western bank of the picturesque and historic Dighalipukhuri. It is one of the oldest Colleges in the north eastern region of India, for girls. The College was established by late Rajabala Das, who was also its first Principal. This visionary lady was convinced that in a country striving to achieve independence, nationhood would require women to occupy their rightful place in the society and that education for women was a priority. The courage of her convictions saw Guwahati Girls' College begin in the premises of Panbazar Girls' High School, in 1939, with just two students on its rolls. In her endeavour to further the cause of women's education, Rajabala Das had the support of the late Radha Kanta Handique, who made generous contributions towards setting up of the College in its present campus, in 1940. It was affiliated to Calcutta University in the same year. The College was later renamed as Handique Girls' College in acknowledgement of the support received from this great philanthropist.

Handique Girls' College is a heritage institution with an eighty-four year history of promoting higher education for women. As an affiliated college under the Gauhati University, it has attained high standards of learning, and its students have borne this out by consistently shining the calling they have found for themselves. The first Women's College in the State has a justified claim to be upgraded to a University and the Government of Assam has been generous in acknowledging this claim.

The College is a provincialized College under the Government of Assam with 20 (twenty) teaching departments offering courses in the Arts and Sciences. Four of these Departments also offer postgraduate courses. The institute is also recognised by the UGC under section 2(f) and 12(B). At present, there are around 2500 students enrolled in the programs of study that are there in the College. Research activities with faculty members involved in funded projects and supervision of Ph.D. students is a part of the academic activity in the College, as is undergraduate research. The College also has an enviable track record in extra-and co-curricular activities, which it supports in keeping with its articulated mission of providing a 'holistic' education for women.

COLLEGE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The College lays great emphasis on discipline and character building of the students. They are always expected to maintain a high standard of discipline. They must abide by the rules and regulations of the College and the hostel.
- 2. At the time of admission, every student shall have to sign a declaration stating that after admission she submits herself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the College authority.
- 3. A student if found guilty of misconduct/indiscipline may be expelled / rusticated for a period /fined /debarred from appearing in any examination for one or more years (on the advice of the Disciplinary Committee).
- 4. All forms of ragging in the Hostel and College campus are strictly prohibited. Any individual or collective act or practice of ragging constitutes gross indiscipline. Strong disciplinary action will be taken against those involved in such activities.
 - a. The Principal, Convenor of the Disciplinary Committee and the Hostel Warden should be immediately informed of any case of ragging. Abetment of ragging or condoning such activities is also punishable. In case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that she has indulged in ragging, her admission may be refused or she shall be expelled from the College.
 - b. Any violation of rules, unsatisfactory progress, irregular attendance, non-clearance of College and hostel dues, discourtesy to faculty members in any form, adoption of unfair means during examinations etc., are some of the offences which may make students liable for disciplinary action such as termination of scholarship, forced transfer and even expulsion from the College and the hostel.
 - c. Students are responsible for their conduct and are prohibited from doing anything either inside or outside the College, which will amount to a breach of discipline and normal functioning of the College.

- d. Students shall conduct themselves in a polite manner towards both the members of the staff (teaching and non-teaching) and towards their fellow students. Insubordination, unbecoming language or any indecent conduct including teasing etc., shall be severely dealt with.
- e. Students must not loiter in the corridors in front of the class rooms and office rooms or in the street in front of the College. During their free time students should work quietly in the library or reading room or spend the time without causing any disturbance.
- f. Any Association or Society of the College will be subjected to such rules and regulations as the College administration may prescribe.
- g. Any notice desired to be posted or circulated by a student anywhere in the College and hostel premises will need the prior approval of the College authority.
- h. All powers of maintenance of discipline are vested with the Head of the Institution and his/her decision shall be final in all such matters.

ATTENDANCE RULES

- a. Attendance in class is compulsory.
- b. All Students are informed that at least 75% attendance in all classes in each subject is mandatory for them. Any aberration will forfeit the benefit of scholarship and other facilities and will not be allowed to sit for any final examination,
- c. Students will be informed about their attendance after the commencement of the classes within a period of 15 days. Those having attendance below 75% are required to make up the shortage within next 30 days.
- d. If they fail to acquire 75% before final examination form fill-up, they will be declared dis-collegiate and debarred from appearing in the end semester examinations to be held by Gauhati University.

CODE OF ETHICS

- Teachers should advance the interest of the teaching profession through value based education
- They will be lifelong learners and engage in continual professional development
- Contribute to the development and promotion of sound educational policy.
- Mentor-mentee system should be effectively implemented.
- They should be involved in dissemination of innovative and quality education.
- Teachers should be good counsellors and facilitators.

- Teachers should responsibly facilitate extra-curricular activities.
- Teachers should carefully engage in all other responsibilities as assigned by authority for overall development of the college.

For the Students:

- Students are expected to maintain the highest standards of discipline and dignified behavior inside as well outside the campus.
- Be aware of and appreciate the Institution goal.
- Be courteous in your dealings with the staff of the College and your fellow students.
- Use all opportunities that the Institution provides for your selfdevelopment.
- Read and retain all information the College provides, check notice boards, and ask for clarification of any information you do not understand.
- Help create an atmosphere conducive to learning.
- Attend all lectures, seminars, tutorials, laboratory classes and other teaching sessions.
- Complete promptly the academic works requested of you and appear all examinations.
- Take the responsibility to seek the support you believe you need and seek advice when your academic progress gives you reason for concern.
- Support the representative role of the Handique Girls' College Students' Union and consider acting as a student representative yourself.
- Provide feedback for improving the learning environment, when it i sought.
- Retain a life-long association with your College.
