

## HANDIQUE GIRLS' COLLEGE SPOT ADMISSION POLICY 2026 -2027

Information for the applicants for Participation in SPOT ADMISSION of FYUGP Courses 2026 – 2027

### KEY POINTS:

- **Registration status:**
  - If you already registered on the Samarth Admission Portal and have a valid Registration Number, you do not need to register again.
  - If you haven't registered, you can register from 13 June 2026 to 17 June 2026 (by 4:00 pm) prior to SPOT admission.
- **Prior applicants:**
  - If you have already applied for a course at Handique Girls' College, you don't need to re-apply. You can modify your application during the Spot Admission counselling at the admission desk.
- **Applicants with no prior application:**
  - If you have not applied for any course yet, you should apply for at least one course. You can modify your choice after counselling at the admission desk during Spot Admission.
- **How admission is determined**
  - On the spot, applicants are taken to the Admission Desk based on a Merit Score (Total marks out of 500, consisting of English plus the Best Four Subjects).
  - After the Merit Score is announced, applicants must report to the Admission Desk immediately.
  - After counselling, admission is granted to the selected course/subject depending on seat availability.
- **Late applicants**
  - Applicants who arrive late can still be considered for admission subject to seat availability.
- **Merit score ranges and dates**
  - **15 June 2026 (subject to seat availability)**
    - FYUGP B.A.: Up to 325
    - FYUGP B.Sc.: Up to 300
    - B.Com.: Open to all
    - BBA: Open to all
    - BCA: Open to all
  - **16 June 2026 (subject to seat availability)**
    - FYUGP B.A.: From 324 to 225
    - FYUGP B.Sc.: From 299 to 225
    - B.Com.: Open to all
    - BBA: Open to all
    - BCA: Open to all
  - **17 June 2026 (subject to seat availability)**
    - Called for admission from merit score 490 and above, descending order, subject to seat availability

### Practical Tips

- If you already have an application, keep it handy and monitor the spot-admission day for any counselling updates.
- If you're applying for the first time, complete your Samarth portal registration, profile creation and Application as early as possible (though it can be done up to 4:00 pm on 17 June 2026).
- Prepare your documents (Marksheet, Caste Certificate if any, Domicile proof (Aadhar card, PRC, Birth Certificate, etc) Ration Card (for Fee Waiver) and a list of preferred courses; you may modify choices at the admission desk during counselling.
- Check seat availability and be ready to report to the Admission Desk promptly after your merit score is announced.
