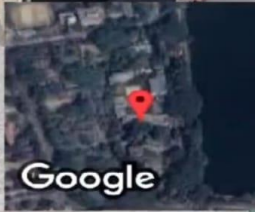
**SKIT PERFORMANCE**

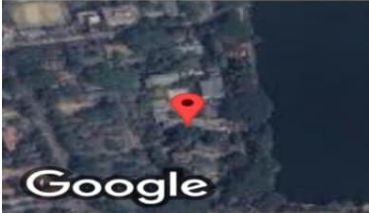
