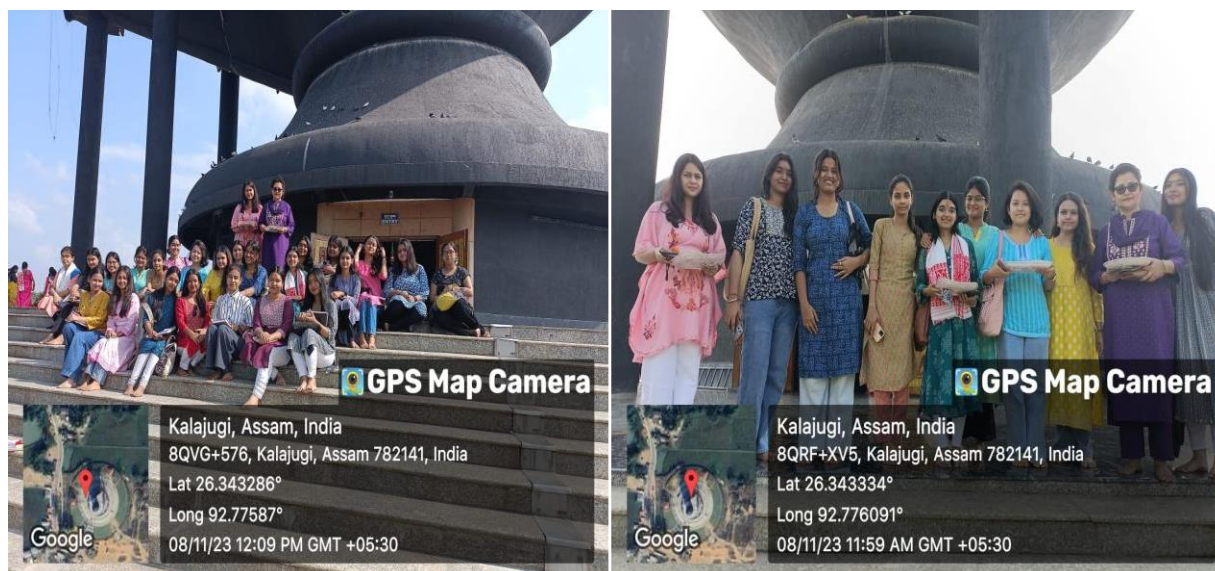

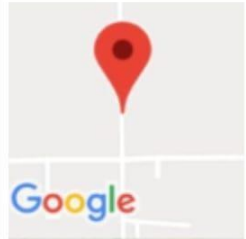

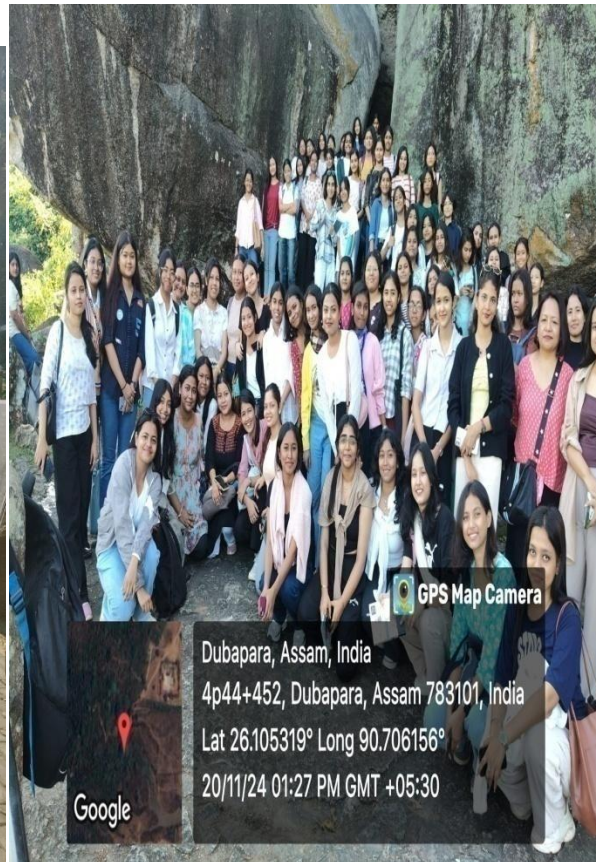

One important thing reveals that the people of Byrnihat have awareness about the garbage disposal and they are trying to do some of the activities with the following:

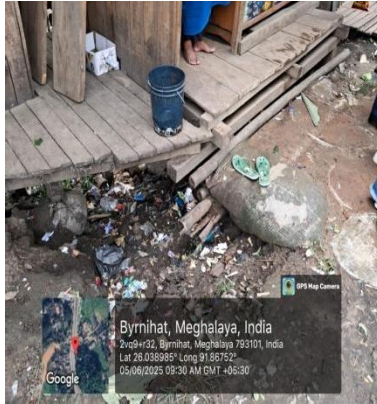
