World Environment Day Date :05/06/2024

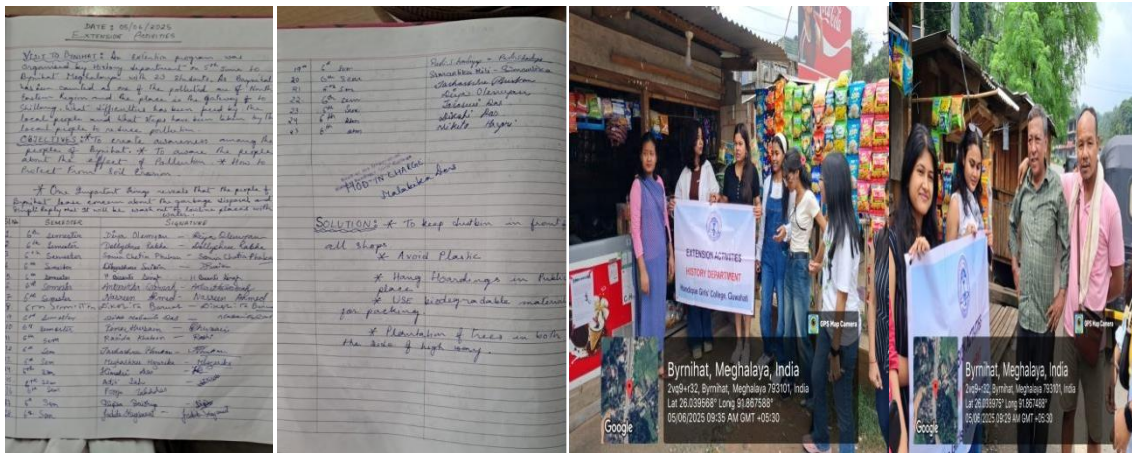

gateway to Shillong, What the difficulties has been faced by the local people and what steps have been taken by the local people to reduce the pollution



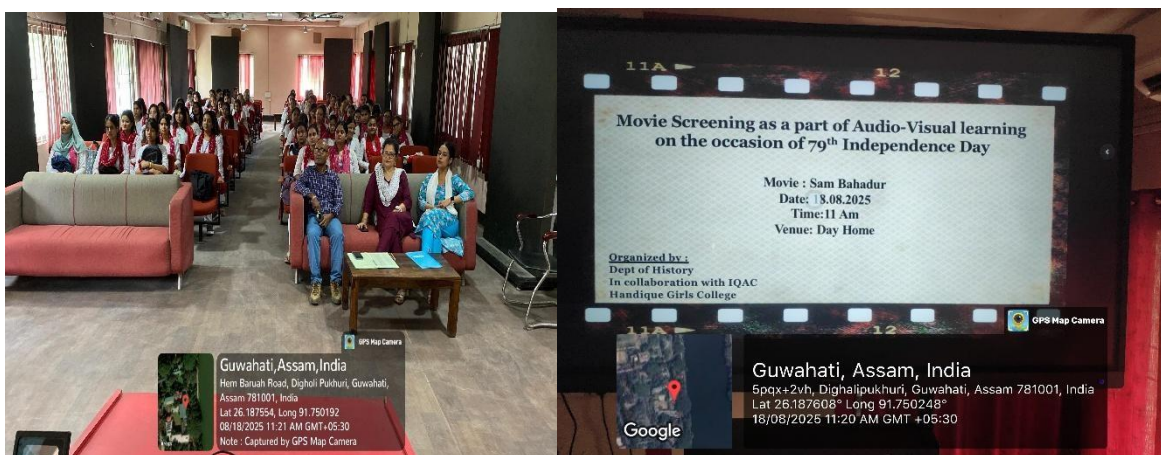
OBSERVED INDEPENDENCE DAY
