The college offers the Higher Secondary course in both Arts and Science streams. These courses are affiliated to Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC), Assam.

**Note:**

1. A student applying for admission in to the Higher Secondary 1st Year Class, in either stream, will study English and a MIL (or Alternative English in lieu of MIL) as core subjects.
2. She will study Environmental Education as a compulsory subject.
3. She will also study a minimum of three and a maximum of four elective subjects, selected from the subjects taught in the College.
4. Students seeking admission into the Higher Secondary Science stream cannot choose all four electives from subjects having practical; a maximum of three subjects with practical will be allowed.  
 Moreover, combinations of subjects a) Biology with Statistics and b) Home Science with Computer Science and Application are not permitted.
5. Students seeking admission into the Higher Secondary Arts stream can opt for only one subject from each of the following groupings.
  - a) Mathematics/ History/ Sanskrit

- b) Logic & Philosophy/ Statistics
- c) Political Science/ Home Science/ Computer Science and Application

There are no restrictions on subjects outside these groupings.

6. Students offering Computer Science & Application in both Arts and Science streams must also offer Mathematics as one of the elective subjects.

### ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- i) Admissions will be fully online. Students will apply for admission through the College's online portal, which will be live with a link from the College website ([www.hgcollege.edu.in](http://www.hgcollege.edu.in))
- ii) All admissions will be based on merit. A merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks secured, out of the total marks (600 for SEBA with suitable conversion for other boards where necessary), by the applicant in the Class X Board Examination.
- iii) Admissions are governed by the College's admission rules and the decision of the Admission Committee regarding admissions is final.

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING

- i) Applicants must carefully read the guidelines before filling up the online form.
- ii) An applicant will submit only one application form for a particular stream. If the applicant is applying to both streams, separate application forms must be filled and submitted for each stream.
- iii) The submitted form must be complete in all respects. Incomplete forms are liable to be rejected. No forms will be accepted once the portal closes.
- iv) While applying, a student must upload digital/scanned copies of the following documents:
  - a) Recent passport size photograph and scanned copy of the candidate's signature in the appropriate place of the form.
  - b) Mark sheet of Class X Board Examination.
  - c) Caste certificate (for reserved category students from Assam)
  - d) Disability certificate from the appropriate medical authority for applicants in the PWD category.

e) Front page of the student's bank pass book showing account no., branch and IFSC code. (The student must provide an undertaking, not to change either the bank details or mobile number provided in the application during the entire course of her study in the College.

f) Documents supporting domicile status. (PRC/Voter ID card of self or parent/NRC of self or parent/Aadhar Card of self or parent/BPL card of family/Birth certificate issued by the Registrar of Births and Deaths/Passport of self or parent). Copy of any one document, supporting the claim of domicile status, has to be provided.

g) Candidate seeking admission against the seats reserved for Extra-curricular category must submit one certificate (the best) acquired in the last 3 (three) years.
